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RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

- Study fielded via online research panel
 - Field Dates: March 10 16, 2014
 - Panel Source: Voice of Alberta & Vision Critical
- n=1688
- Weighted to reflect gender, age, region of Alberta population according to Stats Canada
- Sample of 1688, margin of error, which measures sampling variability, is +/- 2.4%
- Margin of error larger & varies for subsamples



RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

- On March 12, Premier Alison Redford announced that she would be repaying \$45,000 in expenses associated with her South Africa travel (3rd day of study field window)
- To gauge the impact of this announcement on public views, study sample was boosted and field window extended to gather a statistically reliable sample pre & post
- A total of 743 completes prior to Redford repayment announcement &
 945 completes post announcement
- Margin of error, which measures sampling variability for these portions of the total sample:
 - \sim Pre-announcement Wave = +/- 3.6%
 - Post-announcement Wave = +/-3.2%


















PROVINCIAL POLITICAL HORSERACE - DECIDED VOTE -


"If a provincial election were held tomorrow, which one of the following parties' candidate would you, yourself, be most likely to support?"














TRACKING PC VOTE RETENTION/ EROSION

- VOTE INTENTION AMONG APRIL 2012 PC VOTERS -







IMPACT OF REDFORD CONTROVERSY ON FUTURE VOTE - BY LAST PROVINCIAL VOTE -


